Job Description

Project PLASE is seeking drivers to assist with transporting donated furniture and moving clients from our transitional facilities into permanent housing.

Benefits

- Celebrate the successful transition of a client from surviving in unpredictable situations to living in a furnished, stable home
- Provide a positive donation experience to generous members of our community
- Become a member of a team that participates in the acquisition and distribution of approximately 500 pieces of furniture annually

Duties and Expectations

- Assist our clients with moving furniture and belongings while they transition from our housing facilities into their new apartments, houses, or permanent living arrangements
- Pick up the furniture from donors and deliver it to our storage room or to our clients' residences (requires heavy lifting)
- Be punctual, friendly, and courteous
- Valid driver's license (note: use of your own vehicle is preferable, but not required)
- Regular commitment of one 3-6 hour time slot per week
- Teamwork with a partner
- Consistent communication with PLASE staff regarding logistics
- Must comply with all Project PLASE Volunteer Policies and Procedures

Availability: flexible; must coordinate shift with Volunteer Coordinator beforehand
